

## Exhaust Hood Filters

**Products Needed:** Mr. Clean Professional Heavy Duty Degreaser

**Tools Needed:**

- Non-Abrasive Pad
- Nylon Scrub Brush

**Cleaning Frequency:** As needed(at least once a week)

**Preparation:** Review MSDS, products labeling and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

**Special Directions for this Task:** If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.

**Step 1:**

- Remove filters from exhaust hood and take to the sink.
- Submerge exhaust filters or screens in Dawn solution so they are completely under water. Soak exhaust filters for at least 20 minutes. (Overnight if more convenient).

***NOTE:** If entire filter cannot be submerged completely, rotate and submerge other end for at least 20 minutes.*

**Step 2:**

- Scrub exhaust filters using either a hand brush or non-abrasive pad.
- Continue to scrub with brush or non-abrasive pad until clean.

***Note:** If heavy build-up exists, take filters out of the Dawn solution, and spray with Mr. Clean Professional Heavy Duty Degreaser, and let sit for 20 minutes.*

**Step 3:** Allow filters to air-dry.

**Step 4:** Put cleaned filters back into the exhaust hood.

**Step 5:** If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.

**Step 6:** Wash hands before returning to service area.
