

Cleaning Greasy Mop Heads Procedure

Products Needed: Mr. Clean Professional Greasy Floor Cleaner

Tools Needed:

- Dirty mop
- Mop bucket and wringer

Cleaning Frequency: Daily. Change mop head when it becomes permanently soiled or worn.

Preparation: Review MSDS, products labeling and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

Special Directions for this Task: If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.

Step 1:

- Fill a 4-gallon mop bucket to the fill line with warm water.
- Add 3 ounces of Mr. Clean Professional Greasy Floor Cleaner (3/4 oz per gallon of water)

Step 2: Place one dirty mop in the bucket containing cleaning solution and move mop up and down until completely wet.

Step 3: Soak mop head in hot solution in mop bucket for 15 minutes.

Step 4: Move mop up and down in solution.

Step 5: Twist mop in wringer and wring out as much cleaning solution as possible.

Step 6:

- Remove mop from the wringer and take it to the mop sink.
- Run clean, hot water through the mop head at the mop sink until completely rinsed.

Step 7: Place mop back into the wringer and wring out as much water as possible.

Step 8: Hang mop upside down to air dry.

Step 9: Empty mop bucket in mop sink, rinse with warm water, and return to designated storage area.

Step 10: If used, remove and discard disposable gloves. Wash hands before returning to service areas.
