

## Microwave Cleaning Procedure

**Product Needed:** Mr. Clean Professional Disinfecting Multi-Purpose Cleaner

**Tools Needed:**

- Clean towels
- Non-abrasive pad
- Utility bucket

**Cleaning Frequency:** As needed

**Preparation:** Review MSDS, products labeling and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

**Special Directions for this Task:** If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.

**Step 1:**

- Unplug microwave

**Step 2:**

- Fill a clean utility bucket about half full with clean water and place a clean towel in the bucket.
- Carry bucket to the location of the microwave.

**Step 3:**

- Spray Mr. Clean Professional Disinfecting Multi-Purpose Cleaner directly onto all six interior sides of the microwave (4 walls, ceiling and base).

**Step 4:** Using a clean towel from the bucket, wipe surfaces until they are free of any food soil. Rinse towel frequently in water as needed, and use non-abrasive pad to remove any heavy accumulations.

**Step 5:** Plug microwave back into electrical outlet.

**Step 6:**

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to work.
