

Motor Oil Spots (Outside) Cleaning Procedure

Product Needed: Mr. Clean Professional Heavy Duty Degreaser

Tools Needed:

- Eye protection
- Outside deck brush
- Utility bucket
- Hose

Cleaning Frequency: As needed and as weather permits

Preparation: Review MSDS, products labeling and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

Special Directions for this Task: Do not perform this procedure in freezing weather. Use eye protection to guard against chemical splashes.

IMPORTANT: *When cleaning exterior areas, special steps must be taken to avoid polluting rivers and streams. In most municipalities, it is against the Federal Clean Water Act to allow cleaning solutions and rinse water to flow into storm drains or run into the street. All rinse water and cleaning solutions must be collected and disposed of properly.*

Use small amounts of cleaning solution and rinse water. After scrubbing and rinsing, collect all solutions by:

- *Using a wet vac and dispose of it in a sanitary drain (for example, in the mop sink in your place of business) OR*
- *Pick up using absorbent granules (kitty litter-type products) available at auto supply stores. Then double-bag securely in liquid-tight plastic bags and put in the trash.*

Requirements vary. Your Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan should be reviewed with your local Director of Public Utilities prior to implementation.

Step 1:

- **Put on eye protection.**
- Apply Mr. Clean Professional Heavy Duty Degreaser directly onto the area to be cleaned.

Step 2: Scrub spot with a deck brush by applying heavy downward pressure in a back-and-forth motion.

Step 3: Let soak for several hours, or overnight, if convenient.

Step 4:

- After soaking, rinse scrubbed areas off with a hose or buckets of warm water.
- Be sure to rinse any cleaning solution off door frames if any solution splashed onto them.

Note: *On painted surfaces and wall coverings, test a small area before use. If applied to plastic or coated aluminum, wipe immediately and do not soak. Do **not** use on finished floors and natural marble.*

Step 5:

- Wash hands before returning to work.
