

Tables and Chairs

Products Needed: Mr. Clean Professional Disinfecting Multi-Purpose Cleaner

Tools Needed:

- Clean Towels
- Putty Knife

Cleaning Frequency: *Tabletops and Chair Seats: Clean after each use and at close. Chair Legs and Table Bases: Clean at close or as needed.*

Preparation: Review MSDS, products labeling and caution statements. Choose appropriate safety equipment.

Special Directions for this Task: *If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.*

TABLETOPS AND CHAIR SEATS

Step 1:

- Clear table by removing trash and discarding in waste receptacle.
- Remove any gum from tables and chairs with putty knife.

Step 2: Spray Mr. Clean Professional cleaner onto the tabletop holding bottle about 8 to 12 inches away from surface to avoid over-spray

Note: If customers are at nearby tables, spray in a direction that is away from customers, or spray directly onto clean towel.

Step 3:

- Use a clean towel with Mr. Clean Professional Cleaner to wipe tops, sides and underneath edges of tabletop. Allow to air-dry.
- Spray the Mr. Clean Professional Cleaner on the chair seats and wipe with a clean towel.
- Realign tables and chairs as needed.

Note: Replace towel when it becomes dirty.

Step 4:

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.

CHAIR LEGS AND TABLE BASES

Step 1: Wipe chair legs and table bases at close and during the day using the Mr. Clean Professional Disinfecting Multi-Purpose Cleaner and a clean towel.

Note: Do not use abrasive pads on chairs or table bases.

Note: Replace towel when it becomes dirty.

Note: Remove damaged tables/chairs and report damage to manager.

Step 2:

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.
